This will be done through a webinar session which is planned to take place during the last week of **30 October 2024**.

The session is scheduled to cover LOA Safety Applications for all the electrical/electronic products that are within the scope of following compulsory specifications:

- Participants will be shown how to register and navigate the system. They are
 required to have access to product test reports which they can use during the
 demonstration of how to complete an application. (90 minutes)
- Company representatives will then be encouraged to submit multiple applications on the test system during the day.
