COMPULSORY SPECIFICATION FOR REPLACEMENT INCANDESCENT LAMPS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES

I, Alec Erwin, Minister of Trade and Industry, hereby under section 22 (1) (a) (ii) of the Standards Act, 1993 (Act No. 29 of 1993), and on the recommendation of the Council of the South African Bureau of Standards, declare the specification contained in the Schedule to be a compulsory specification for replacement incandescent lamps for motor vehicles with effect from the date six months after publication of this notice.

SCHEDULE

COMPULSORY SPECIFICATION FOR REPLACEMENT INCANDESCENT LAMPS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES

1. Scope

- 1.1 This specification covers incandescent lamps that are offered for sale as replacement parts for use in motor vehicles of categories M, N or O.
- 1.2 This specification does not cover lamps for use in motor cycles or in off-road vehicles such as agricultural or earth-moving machines.

2. Definitions

For the purposes of this specification, the definitions given in SABS 1376-1, *Lights for motor vehicles—Part 1: Incandescent lamps* (as amended), as published in Government Notice No. 563 (*Government Gazette* No. 8827) of 29 July 1983, and the following definition apply:

Lamp: An electric incandescent lamp that is intended for use in headlights or in secondary lights of motor vehicles of categories M, N and O.

3. Category

A lamp shall be of one of the categories covered by SABS 1376-1.

4. Requirements

A lamp shall comply with the requirements for lamps of normal production as given in the following clauses/subclauses of SABS 1376-1:

- 3.1 Bulbs
- 3.2 Caps
- 3.2.1 Dimensions
- 3.2.2 Securing of caps
- 3.3 Aging
- 3.4 Filament shape and position
- 3.5 Lamp dimensions
- 3.6 Colour
- 3.7 Initial power and initial luminous flux
- 4. Marking

5. Equivalent requirements

Lamps that are marked with the SABS mark, the E mark, or other recognized approval mark, indicating compliance with an equivalent specification, may be deemed to comply with the requirements of this specification.
