

Requirements for export of fish and fishery products

1. Administrative requirements

- 1.1. Product must be from an approved establishment
- 1.2. A valid export permit from DAFF is required for live products.
- 1.3. Aquaculture products from an approved farm by DAFF with valid movement document if packed in a pack-house or establishment

2. <u>Inspection request</u>

- 2.1. A BF80 form must be completed and reflect the following information;
 - a) Packers code/establishment number
 - b) Date codes/ Batch codes (per packer)
 - c) Estimated quantities per code
- 2.2. Name and address of exporter or exporting company (consignor);
- 2.3. Destination(s) of product(s) and vessel(s) on which product(s) are to be exported;
- 2.4. Date of loading of the product(s) and date of departure of the vessel;
- 2.5. A true description of the contents to be exported, i.e. net mass, number of cartons and breakdown of the different size grading;
- 2.6. Any additional tests to be performed as required by the authorities of the country to which the product is being exported;
- 2.7. Location where samples can be drawn/inspected for inspection purposes and the name of a contact person at the said location.

3. Application for a health certificate

- 3.1. Once the container(s) have been loaded a Final Loading form (BF60) must be completed with the following information:
- 3.2. Container number and complete list of commodities per container, including the establishment number and date codes/batch codes of each packer's commodity(ies) in the container and the number of cartons and net weight per establishment number and date code.
- 3.3. Name and address of consignee and consignor
- 3.4. Name of vessel and voyage number.
- 3.5. Sailing date.
- 3.6. Country (destination) and port of discharge.

Compliance with above will enable the NRCS to issue the necessary documents timeously.
